Angelos Papadopoulos (Athens, 1991)

Angelos Papadopolous is a choreographer, director and performer.

Angelos' choreographic and other related digital and performance work look to create impactful experiences for audiences where the body is foregrounded as a key site of social, political, and aesthetic ideas and pleasures. His impulse is to continuously explore the possibilities of choreographic forms in relation to audience engagement initiatives that are both live or digital or a hybrid version of these.

Queer perspectives, intersectionality, and radical play form the catalyst for much of his work. His work can have a strong autobiographic element as a way to explore his own lived experience and how that connects with other people and places. The body as a social and sensuous reality remains a central concern in his creative processes.

He studied Economics at the Athens University of Economics & Business and Dance at the National School of Dance and the Greek National Opera Dance School. He is currently completing his MRes Choreography & Performance at the University of Roehampton in London, where he was awarded an Alumni Referral Scholarship.

Currently, Angelos has been forming a participatory artistic practice around the issue of father while he's elaborating his new choreography 'The gravity between us'.

Additionally, he was awarded an International Festival (Bilbao) Act Residency Award for the 'Subject of interest is the boy from wherever;', a choreographic duet presented at the Guggenheim Museum, Bilbao, Spain. He was awarded a Stavros Niarchos Foundation Artist Fellowship in 2020-21 and a Stegi Onassis Cultural Center Fellowship to attend a residency at the CND (Centre National De La Danse) in Paris in June 2021.

He is a founder of 'Cicada's Call' Dance Company and member of 'Atrial' Civil Non-Profit Organization (GR) as well as a member of 'Room to Bloom', a platform for young feminist artists & Polygreen Culture & Art Initiative, a cultural organization focusing on environmental consciousness and sustainable practices.

His performances have been shown in Germany (Tanzahoi International Dance & Dance Film Festival), Greece (Megaron, the Athens Concert Hall), Spain (Act International Festival for Emerging Performing Artists) & Taiwan (Take part in Taiwan Festival). His short films have been screened in festivals in France, Georgia, Greece, Germany (audience award), Mexico, Portugal, South America, U.S.A. & Spain and in more than 20 cities in Europe courtesy of the Freiraum Festival.

While working on his projects he also collaborates as a dance performer with various directors and choreographers including John Fulljames & Maxine Joanna Braham (Göteborg Opera, Greek National Opera, Royal Danish Opera), Spyros Kouvaras (Bageion Hotel, Delphi Archaeological Site, Roes Theater), Christos Papadopoulos (Greek Festival), Thomas Moschopoulos (Greek National Opera), Rootless Root (Hellenic Dance Company) and others.
